



ENCINAL YACHT CLUB Centennial Cup April 17, 2010 Notice of Race

Rules: The Racing rules of sailing 2009-2012 (RRS), the Prescriptions of US Sailing, the sailing Instructions and this Notice of Race shall govern this regatta. This is an invitation only regatta and is classified **Category A**.

Eligibility: This Regatta is open to all West Coast Yacht Clubs that have been chartered for one hundred years or more at the time of the Regatta date. All members of the sailing crew must be members in good standing of the yacht club they are representing.

Declaration of Trust: This Regatta will be sailed within the Centennial Cup Declaration of Trust provided three or more entries are secured.

Racing Area: All races will be sailed in the South Bay / NAS2 area, approximately .5 nm south of Alameda Island.

Start: first warning will be 12:55 hours.

Scoring: The Low Point scoring system will be used. No discards will be allowed.

Sailing Instructions: Sailing Instructions will be available at the Registration desk in the EYC Clubhouse and online at www.encinal.org

Registration: Competitors may enter by completing the entry and crew forms and submitting them to the Encinal YC office no later than 19:00 hours Thursday April 15, 2010. Regatta Fee: \$50.00 payable to EYC.

Classes Invited: The regatta will be sailed in J 105 sailboats. Class rules will apply except for the following changes:

1. Section 3 requiring membership is deleted in total.
2. Section 4.2 is amended to read "All skippers"
3. Section 6.8, 6.8.1, 6.8.2, 6.9 and 6.10 are deleted and only "B" Fleet sails can be used in the Regatta. All sails must have the appropriate sail tags in accordance to Fleet rules.
4. Section 7.1 will apply. Weight will only be measured upon protest.
5. No professionals are allowed to participate in the regatta.

Measurement: All boats must conform to class measurement requirements and weight restrictions.

Trophies: Trophies will be awarded after the Regatta Reception Saturday night. An optional dinner follows the awards presentation. Please make dinner reservations with the club at 510-522-3272.
