Notice of Race

Rules: The current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, the rules of one-design classes, and the sailing instructions will govern racing. The series is designated Category A.

Classes Invited: Boat owned and skippered by Encinal Yacht Club members with valid PHRF certificates.

Eligibility requirements: Yachts must be a mono-hull, have an overall length of at least 20 feet and a minimum weight of 10,000 lbs. All yachts must comply with the U.S. Coast Guard equipment requirements for recreational vessels. The Skipper and 25% of the crew must be members of Encinal Yacht Club. A club member must own the boat.

Registration: Deliver the completed Entry Form, current PHRF Certificate, to the Encinal Yacht Club office by 5:00pm April 17th, 2010. Fax 510-865-8630 or e-mail at rearcommandore@encinal.org

Schedule of Race: The race is scheduled as follows:

April 18th, 2010 Warning Signal 11:55 a.m.

Racing Area: Around Alcatraz Island, YRA 8, (either direction) and Treasure Island (either direction) and down the Oakland Estuary.

Sailing Instructions: Will be available at Encinal Yacht Club no later than April 17th, 2009 and a copy will be posted on the EYC web page (www.encinal.org)

Scoring: The low point scoring system, rule A2, will apply.

PHRF Scoring: Time on Time handicapping system will be used.

Trophies: Will be awarded at Encinal Yacht Club after the finish of the race April 18th
