



**ENCINAL YACHT CLUB**  
**GRACIE & GEORGE REGATTA**  
**DOUBLE HANDED, FEMALE SKIPPER / MALE CREW**

**Sunday, AUGUST 8, 2010**

This is your invitation to join the many boats that participate every year in this popular and fun double handed race. The start is south of the bay bridge and uses south bay courses with a downwind finish at Encinal Yacht Club. Membership in a Yacht Club is not required.

This regatta is governed by the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing and the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association. It is a Category A Regatta. Entries are open to monohull displacement sailboats and Multi-Hulls with an overall length of at least 20 feet. Custom/customized boats must provide a current PHRF Certificate with their entry form in order to be eligible to race. Standard production boats which do not have a current PHRF Certificate will be assigned a rating by the Race Committee. Ratings so assigned cannot be contested. Boats may fly a spinnaker once they reach the mouth of the Estuary with non-spinnaker boats receiving a 9 second per mile rating advantage.

All yacht classes will be eligible for class trophies as well as the overall Gracie and George Trophy, however to equalize the field an additional 3 second per mile penalty will be assigned to all multi-hull and sport boat classes. Sport boats include Melges 24, J-80, Antrim 27, Azzura 310, Pyramid 660, Wylie Wabbits or other boats of similar weight and design to be designated solely at the Race Committee's discretion.

The Race Committee may reject the entry of any Yacht at their discretion.

The overall winner will have their name added to the Perpetual Trophy and may display the trophy at their Yacht Club. The presentation of the perpetual trophy and division trophies will take place at the Encinal Yacht Club following the race.
