

Jack Frost Series 2016 – 2017

November 12, 2016; January 21, February 25, and March 18, 2016

Organizing Authority: Encinal Yacht Club, Alameda, CA

Notice of Race

1. Rules: This series will be governed by the *Racing Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions of US Sailing, and the rules of one-design classes, except as any of these are changed by this Notice of Race

and the Sailing Instructions.

2. Eligibility: The series is open to one-design classes and boats with a valid NCPHRF certificate.

3. Registration: The entry fee is \$100, or \$110 if received after November 9; US Sailing members

receive a \$10.00 discount. Eligible boats must register using jibaset.

4. Schedule:

4.1 Races will be held

Saturday, Nov. 12, 2016

Saturday, Jan. 21, 2017

Saturday, Feb. 25, 2017

Saturday, Mar. 18, 2017

4.2 Two races are scheduled each day.

4.3 The first Warning signal each day is scheduled for 11:25.

5. Sailing Instructions: Will be posted on the EYC website by Wednesday, Nov. 9, 2016.

Addendums, if applicable, will be posted by 5:00 pm on Friday, November 11, 2016.

6. Racing Area: The racing area will be in the vicinity of YRA #10; the start line is approx. 0.5 nm

west of the end of Berkeley Pier ruins.

7. Scoring:

7.1 The low point scoring system, rule A2, will apply. PHRF time-on-time scoring will be used.

7.2 Four races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

7.3 When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race

scores.

7.4 When five to six races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race

scores excluding her worst score.

7.5 When seven or eight races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race

scores excluding her two worst scores.

8. Trophies: "Race Day Winner" awards for each Division will be given in the EYC Lounge at the conclusion of each day's races. Series trophies will be given in the EYC Lounge after the race on March 18, 2017
