NOTICE OF RACE

1 ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

- 1.1 The Organizing Authority (OA) for this regatta is Encinal Yacht Club (EYC).

2 RULES

- 2.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and Santana 22 Class Rules available at <http://santana22.org/articles/rules>.
- 2.2 RRS 40 is changed as follows: All competitors are required to wear a personal flotation device while racing except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. The "Y" flag will not be displayed.
- 2.3 RRS 44 is changed to require a one (1) turn penalty.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Santana 22 Class whose skipper is a member in good standing of their respective Santana 22 Class Association as of the date of their entry.
- 3.2 Entry will be via registration at <http://santana22.org/articles/Nationals>.
- 3.3 An entry will be considered complete when the form is submitted and regatta entry fees paid.
- 3.4 Entries will close at 10 am on Saturday, July 22, 2017.

4 ADVERTISING

- 4.1 Advertising shall be permitted in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20.

5 FEES

- 5.1 The entry fee is \$125.00.
- 5.2 Entries received after July 15, 2017 will be subject to an additional fee of \$25
- 5.3 The fee provides race entry, Saturday evening Dinner for one (1) person, the Annual Santana 22 Class Meeting, and Sunday awards.
- 5.4 Additional Saturday dinner tickets are available at registration along with pre-order for box lunch.

6 SCHEDULE

6.1 No more than 5 (five) races may be sailed.

6.2 The schedule of events is as follows:

Friday July 21st:

10:00 Registration and check-in. Measurements as needed.

14:00 First Warning; optional practice races (short courses). Two races scheduled.

Saturday July 22nd:

11:55 First Warning; three (3) races scheduled with a short break in between each race.

18:00 Class meeting.

18:30 Dinner and Poolside Party (one dinner included in Registration fee, additional dinners for purchase).

Sunday July 23rd:

11:55 First Warning; two (2) races scheduled with a short break in between. No warning signal shall be fired after 16:00.

Awards presentation at EYC after racing.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7.1 Sailing instructions will be available at registration, the EYC Notice Board, and <http://santana22.org/articles/Nationals> no later than July 19, 2017 at 11:59pm.

7.2. The official notice board will be located outside of the easternmost window of the downstairs Regatta Room facing the lawn at EYC.

8 VENUE & COURSES

8.1 Races will be conducted in:

8.1.1 San Francisco Bay south of the San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge, west of the island of Alameda; or,

8.1.2 San Francisco Bay north of the San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge in the vicinity of YRA #10; the start line is approx. 0.5 nm west of the end of Berkeley Pier ruins

8.2 The courses will be specified in the Sailing Instructions.

9 SCORING

9.1 The low point scoring system, rule A2, will apply.

9.2 Three (3) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

9.3 All completed races will be counted towards awards.

10 AWARDS

10.1 Trophies will be awarded for the top five (5) finishers overall.

11 PHOTOGRAPHY CONSENT

11.1 Competitors entering the regatta accept that they may be photographed and/or videotaped participating in the race and/or using Encinal Yacht Club's facilities and they consent to the taking of such images and to the use, reuse, publication and republication of such images in any media, in conjunction with the competitor's name or not without compensation and without the competitors approval of such images or any use thereof.

12 BERTHING

- 12.1 Santana 22s will be accommodated free of charge at EYC from July 20 to July 23, 2017. Thereafter storage fees will apply. Contact the port captain beforehand to arrange space. The hoist may be used with an Encinal member present during its operation.

13 HOUSING

- 13.1 The Marina Village Inn is next to EYC, and other local accommodations are nearby.

- 14.1 Competitors shall participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4. The organizing authority does not accept any liability for material injury, personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.
