NOTICE OF RACE

1.0 RULES

- 1.0 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The racing Rules of Sailing 2017 2020.
- 1.2 Competitors are required to wear USCG approved PFD's while racing. No "Y" flag will be flown.
- 1.3 US Sailing Appendix V1 applies. (V1 modifies RRS 44.1 to allow one turn penalty if rules of Part 2 Are broken...)
- 1.4 Appendix U AUDIBLE SIGNAL RACING SYSTEM will replace RRS 26. (A three minute starting sequence)

2.0 ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 All one design centerboard and keelboat classes of small boats except the Optimist Pram are invited.
- 2.2 Class membership is not required for this race.
- 2.3 All boats entering will be accommodated.

3.0 REGISTRATION

- 3.1 Entry fee for each race is ten dollars (\$10.00).
- 3.2 Fleet entry fee, five boats or more boat in same class, is seven dollars (\$7.00) per boat.
- 3.3 Eligible boats must register the morning of the race at the Regatta Desk. Located at the entry of the EYC boatyard.
- 3.4 All entries must provide home phone and email for safety reasons.

4.0 SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 4.1 Race Dates Mar 18, April 15, May 20, June 17, July 15, Aug 19, Sept. 17
- 4.1 Sailors meeting at 1200 hrs. each day.
- 4.2 Scheduled time for the First warning Signal will be 1230 hrs. each day.
- 4.3 No starts will occur after 1630 hrs.
- 4.4 Five races, weather permitting, are planned each day.

5.0 BOATS and EQUIPMENT

5.1 Rough compliance with the intent of class rules is the spirit of this event. Entry affirms their boat and equipment is roughly in compliance with class rules.

6.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Sailing Instructions will be available on the EYC website by Monday March 13, 2017. A copy of the SI's, NOR and Appendix U will be available at the regatta desk.

7.0 COURSES and RACING AREA

- 7.1 The racing area will be the Inner Harbor Entrance Channel section directly in front of the EYC.
- 7.2 The courses will be windward leeward using inflatable marks with a typical time of approximately thirty minutes.

8.0 SCORING

- 8.1 When three or fewer races are completed all races will be scored.
- 8.2 When four or more races are completed, boats worse score will be excluded.
- 8,3 Each day is scored individually by class.

9.0 PRIZES

9.1 Each class winner will receive a, "Race Day Winner Glass".

10.0 BOAT AND TRAILER STORAGE

- 10.1 All cars and trailers to be parked in south west parking lot used for boat storage.
- 10.2 Only boat and trollies allowed in boatyard.
