



2018 - 2019 Jack Frost Series

NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 This series will be governed by the *Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017-2020*, the prescriptions of US Sailing, and the rules of one-design classes, except as any of these are changed by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

2 ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 These series are open to all boats that have an overall length of at least 20 feet, with current Northern California PHRF certificates, and one-design classes. All boats must comply with the U.S. Coast Guard equipment requirements for recreational vessels including proper navigation lights.
- 2.2 One-design divisions will be five or more boats. If a one-design class does not fulfill the 5-boat minimum, they will be started and scored in the appropriate handicap division. All one-design classes are encouraged to drive up participation - we look forward to more one-design starts!

3 REGISTRATION

- 3.1 All entry fees shall be paid during online registration at: Jibeset.com
- 3.2 a) The entry fee is U.S. \$135.00 if paid before October 29, 2018.
b) The entry fee is U.S. \$150.00 if paid October 29, 2018 through November 3, 2018.
c) The entry fee is U.S. \$ 35.00 per race day after Nov. 3, 2018.

4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 The series shall consist of 5 days of racing;
Nov. 3, 2018
Dec. 1, 2018
Jan. 5, 2019
Feb. 2, 2019
Mar. 2, 2019
- 4.2 Two races are scheduled for each day
- 4.3 First warning is scheduled for 11:25 AM each day

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1 Sailing instructions will be posted on the Encinal.org no later than Wednesday Oct.31, 2018. Addendums, if applicable will be posted by Friday Nov. 2, 2018.

6 RACING AREA

The race area will be the vicinity of the west end of the Berkeley Pier, approximately .5 miles NE of Treasure Island.

7 SCORING

- 7.1 The low point scoring system, rule A2, will apply. PHRF time-on-time scoring will be used.
- 7.2 Six races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 7.3 When eight races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 7.4 When ten races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst two scores.
- 7.5 PHRF Scoring: TIME ON TIME handicapping system will be used. A 3 second per mile advantage will be given to any boat that has one or more EYC Junior sailors or first year Club members on board. Those persons must be shown to the RC prior to each start. After each race the race results will be posted in the EYC Bar.

8 TROPHIES

- 8.1 "Race Day Winner" awards for each Division will be given in the EYC Lounge at the conclusion of each day's races.
- 8.2 Series trophies will be given in the EYC Lounge after the race on March 3, 2019.

9 ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

- 9.1 The Organizing Authority for the Jack Frost Series is the Encinal Yacht Club.
